*****NEW*** WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF CREATION** World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, which runs from 1 September to 4 October 2024: "Hope and Act with Creation" is the theme of this year's ecumenical Season of Creation inspired from the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans (Rom 8:19-25). In his message, Pope Francis encourages "to live an incarnational faith, one that can enter into the suffering and hope-filled "flesh" of others; to join forces to help to rethink, "among other things, the question of human power, its meaning, and its limits; to extend harmony among humanity and to creation in the sense of responsibility for a humane and integral ecology, the path of salvation of our common home". With the assistance of the Holy Spirit seek to live "a life that becomes a song of love for God, for humanity, with and for creation, and that finds its fullness in holiness."
