\*\*\*NEW\*\*\* SAINTS OF THE WEEK: 7th December: St Ambrose (339-397 Born at Trier, the son of the Roman Praetorian Prefect of Gaul, he was trained as a lawyer and practiced as such. In 370 he was made Governor of Aemilia – Romagna with his headquarters at Milan. On the death of the Bishop of Milan he was elected to the post much against his will and despite the fact that he wasn't yet baptised. He became famous as a preacher and was a champion of religion, morality and justice. Not afraid to bring pressure on the civil authorities, he went as far as excommunicating the Emperor Theodosius at one point. He also promoted the use of music in Church and a number of his hymns are still well known. Regarded as being one of the great pillars of the Western Church.

13th December: St Lucy (d.303) Lucy was a native of Syracuse in Sicily who openly proclaimed her Christianity by distributing all her goods to the poor. This was at the time of the Great Persecution under the Emperor Diocletian, when Christianity was proscribed. She was denounced by her former fiancée and put to death for her faith in 303. Patron of the blind and those with eye trouble.
