*****NEW*** SAINTS OF THE WEEK: 23rd Nov: St Clement (c.96) Pope and Martyr** The third Bishop of Rome after St Peter and author of a letter to the Church in Corinth which had asked him to arbitrate in a dispute. His life and letter afford valuable evidence for the state of the Church in Rome and the development of the ministry. His Church in Rome is remarkable in that it stands over three levels of excavations.
