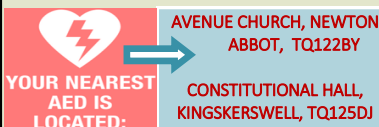

The coach will leave promptly at 5.30pm and drop us a few hundred yards from the entrance to the cathedral (the coach may be too big to drop us outside the main entrance). There is another postbox in the narthex at St Joseph's (next to the entrance doors), where payments can also be left (envelopes are available next to the list).
