NEW SAINTS OF THE WEEK: 28th October: Ss Simon and Jude Apostles Little is known about either of these two saints except that they are listed in the Gospels as being Apostles. Jude is associated with James 'the brother of the Lord' either as his son or his brother. Simon is thought to have belonged to the Zealots (a party of political activists before following Christ). Jude is the Patron of "Hopeless cases".

NEW THE APPOINTMENT OF THE RIGHT REVERENT NICHOLAS HUDSON AS BISHOP OF

PLYMOUTH - a message from Canon Paul Cummins, Diocesan Administrator. 'I am very pleased to announce that His Holiness Pope Leo XIV has appointed the Right Reverend Nicholas Hudson as the new Bishop of Plymouth. Bishop Nicholas brings a wealth of experience to the role having served the Church as a priest for over thirty five years; as assistant priest, as parish priest, as Director of the Southwark Christian Education Centre, as Vice-Rector and as Rector of the English College in Rome, and most recently as Auxiliary Bishop for the Diocese of Westminster.

Bishop Nicholas' installation as Diocesan Bishop will be on the 29 November at the Cathedral Church of Saint Mary and Saint Boniface, Plymouth.

I know that you will welcome Bishop Nicholas with the same kindness and open hearts that our diocese is known for. Over the next few weeks, I will let you know more about the installation, as well as opportunities for you to meet our new bishop personally.

As Bishop Nicholas prepares to serve the people of the Diocese of Plymouth, I invite you to pray that the Saints will be close to him and will keep him in their care. May the Holy Spirit continue to guide and inspire him over the weeks ahead. Please join me in welcoming Bishop Nicholas to our diocesan family.'

STOP ASSISTED SUICIDE - FURTHER ACTION NEEDED! As you may have seen, at the Second Reading of the Leadbeater assisted suicide Bill in the House of Lords, a record number of Peers spoke. Of those who took a position, around two-thirds opposed the assisted suicide Bill. That is more than double the number who supported it. This momentum has been built by tens of thousands of people writing to Peers in opposition. The Bill is now at Select Committee stage. Sending a physical letter carries particular weight with Members of the House of Lords. Right To Life UK has created a simple tool that generates personalised letters to Peers, each focused on a specific area of concern. You can then print them, or copy them out by hand, sign, and post them.
