NEW* PARISH LUNCH 30TH APRIL—SEE YOU THERE Our next Parish Lunch will take place on Wed 30th April. To minimise our food wastage there are a few changes that you should be aware of:-- we are introducing a new booking system which means that when you arrive for your lunch on 30th April, we will ask you to select your menu options for the next lunch on 28th May (if you intend to come). You will then receive a 'reservation number' and details about most importantly how to contact us if you're unable to attend · There will be a maximum number of guests and this will not exceed 36 (we will have a stand by list) · As we will be cooking a specific meal chosen by you it is absolutely essential that you let us know if you're unable to come along as somebody on the standby list may be able to take your place · We are looking for help in preparing meals. Could you cook a starter, main or dessert for 20 people? We can reimburse the cost of ingredients. If you would like more information on what dishes we are planning please speak to Angie.

NEW* MESSAGE FROM DEBORRAH BACK Thank you for supporting our homeless community. I have been asked by Nick, chair of Factory Row to "convey gratitude to the parish of St Joseph's for your continued support of our homeless population locally, your Christmas gifts bring great joy to those we distribute them to on your behalf". This year we were fortunate to be able to provide each person with a small Easter egg to help them celebrate Easter. To assist this charity giving in 2025. I would like to start up the monthly collections we used to have, so that the team of wrappers are not swamped at Christmas. If you are willing and able we would like to collect the following at the back of the church each month: May - toothbrushes or toothpaste June - 2in1 shampoo and conditioner July - gender neutral soap or flannel August - wooden nail brush (Home bargain is normally cheapest) or men's comb Sept - shower gel (predominantly for men) Oct warm black socks or hand or body cream Nov - Small bars of chocolate, tubs of chocolates ie celebrations etc or bags of toffees. On 9th November we will also have a collection for those who cannot shop but want to contribute. Dec - there will be a money collection; and we will have a collection of nice foods for the Christmas hamper. Of course, if you have any of these items laying around at home you wish to donate, you don't have to wait please pop them in the basket at the back of the church.
