**HELPING HANDS:** Our 50:50 club, Helping Hands is a simple and effective way of raising funds. Half of the money raised by subscriptions is kept by us for the benefit of our Essential Grants programme and Pro-active Parenting courses, and the other half is returned to members as prize money. For example, if we have £200 in subscriptions from members each month, then £100 would be used to help children and their families/carers and the other £100 will be distributed as prize money e.g. £50 first prize, £30 second prize and £20 third prize. The distribution of the prize money will be determined each time by the number of members in the draw. It costs £12 a year for one entry into all twelve monthly draws. You can enter each draw more than once by increasing your subscription to £24 for two entries, £36 for three and so on. If your name is drawn out, we will post a cheque to you.
